# Minutes – November 3, 2021

## Unfinished Business

- Chapter 1, Teaching, of the "Canonical Standards for Parishes" was discussed.
  - Look into online training opportunities for cathecists at the parish level to obtain certification.
  - Work to have increased participation of parishioners at the school by encouraging enrollment of school- aged children.
  - Christian Formation classes are being lightly attended.
  - As a result of a limitation of activities due to the pandemic, church and functions have dropped off. Efforts are needed to resume activities within the parish.
- The WVU ministry had no new information. Father did indicate that he will most likely be appointed to be the campus minister by the diocese.
- Father is still exploring a Hispanic ministry at the parish through the Missionary Servants of the Word. He has been in communication with the community and could possible have someone assigned and here as early as January 2022. The house which would be used for the convent is still occupied by the previous tenants.
- The Liturgy Committee met with Father Leonard and developed a schedule for Christmas masses. Masses will be celebrated at 5 on 12/24 and at 12 AM (midnight mass) and 10 AM on 12/25. A Saturday 5 PM vigil mass will not be celebrated on 12/25. Mass will be celebrated at the regular times on Sunday 12/26.
- A meeting with Father and the Evangelization Committee has not been scheduled.
- There is nothing to report on the desire to have more programs for young adults.
