Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come

The next segment of the Great Adventure Bible Study is about to begin! **Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come** is an 11-part Bible study by Jeff Cavins. In this intriguing look at one of the most talked-about books in Scripture, Jeff Cavins explores Revelation to demonstrate how the Kingdom established by Christ in His Church is intimately connected with the Kingdom of Heaven, especially through the celebration of the Mass. In this study, you will learn what all the mysterious figures and images of Revelation represent, as well as what will happen during the Second Coming of Christ, what has already happened, and what is happening NOW in salvation history.

Like our previous Bible Studies, there will be two tracks that will run simultaneously:

Track I: Morning Track

Track I sessions will meet in DeSales Hall each Thursday after the morning mass, from approximately 9:15 – 11:15 a.m., beginning Thursday, March 6, 2025 (Thursday after Ash Wednesday) and will run for 11 weeks, with the exception of Holy Thursday and Easter Thursday.

Track II: Evening Track

Track II sessions are identical to those in Track I, and are for those who cannot participate in the weekday morning sessions. Track II sessions will also meet in DeSales Hall each Thursday evening from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m., beginning Thursday, March 6, 2025 (Thursday after Ash Wednesday) and will run for 11 weeks, with the exception of Holy Thursday and Easter Thursday.

You will also need a Catholic Bible (The program uses the Revised Standard Version (RSV) Catholic Edition, but any Catholic translation will do) and a copy of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, which will be made available for those who do not already have a copy. For those who have participated in *The Bible Timeline* program, you will find it helpful to keep your Bible Timeline and/or Bible Timeline Bookmark with you throughout this study.
